Welcome Meeting 6.30pm today at the marquee.

If this is your first visit to Keswick Convention a particularly warm welcome to you. We hope this leaflet will give you some useful information about where to find things. The campsite team (wearing blue lanyards) are here to help so do ask any of us if you have a query. The pitch number of the person on duty is posted on the marquee noticeboard. Toilets and showers are in the car park.

Saturday at 6:30 by the marquee there will be a short welcome meeting to give you information about the running of the camp. Please send at least 1 person from your pitch.

- Everyone is warmly welcomed to our daily prayer meeting in the marquee at 8:15am (Sunday 8.30am)
- There will be a campsite picnic one lunchtime please look out for which day on the marquee noticeboard.
- You can freeze your freezer blocks. These can be dropped off at the marquee at any time and frozen ones can be collected between 9-10am and 5-6pm. Bags and marker pens are available to clearly mark with your surname & pitch number.
- The marquee will be streaming the main events for the team and for those who have to remain on site.
- The marquee is the main information point with a detailed noticeboard, with maps and the full weeks programme. (Copies are available.)
- On Saturday afternoon we are serving refreshments so please pop in for a brew and meet some of the campsite team.
- Phone charging is available in a trailer between 9am-9pm.
- Should you need to vacate your pitch before next Saturday please let the Site Manager know so our site records can be updated.
- Friends and family are welcome on site, please just be aware of your neighbours.

Waste Water Disposal for 2023

To meet new planning requirements, all our waste water is having to be removed daily by road tanker.

Please help us reduce our water waste by not leaving taps running in the toilets and keeping shower times as short as possible.

All waste water on the fields must be placed in the big plastic containers.

A new grey waste and toilet waste emptying facility is provided beyond the last toilet block.

Dish Washing Up Facilities

Hot water will again be available by the marquee for dish washing.

Please follow instructions for water disposal.

Campsite Showers are open between 7am- 9pm

There are 10 portable showers located on the car park. Please be considerate in the time spent in the shower, we are suggesting no more 10 minutes per shower and change.

Please leave the shower door open as you leave and leave it clean. The showers will be cleaned around midday and early evening so some may be closed temporarily. This is for everyone's safety.

Campsite Toilets

There are 3 identical toilet units each with a single toilet & wash-basin, and a cubicle with 3 toilets and 3 washbasins.

The 3 single toilets are unisex, and then there will be 2 female and 1 male units. There is 1 portable level access toilet in the car park, and 3 portable toilets in field 2.

Enjoy Keswick 2023

A safe and happy camp for everyone relies on us all following a few simple rules and requirements:

- Please ensure everyone wear their wristbands at all times. This is for all our safety, so we can identify any strangers on the campsite. Replacements are available from the marquee. Please write your pitch number on any child's wristband in case they wander off.
- Please keep noise to a minimum between 11pm – 7am, and don't be offended if someone asks you to keep quiet between these times.
- There are lots of children on site, please keep them, and others, safe by keeping your speed to 5mph while driving on site.
- Some people are wary of dogs so please keep yours on a short lead, exercise them off site and pick up poo. Do not leave dogs unattended.
- We have a good relationship with the farmers, help us keep it that way by protecting the grass. All BBQs, whether gas or charcoal, must be 30cm off the ground and must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times. No disposable BBQs, fire pits, open fires or Chimeneas are permitted on site, nor is the gathering of firewood or other combustible materials.
- In wet weather we operate a 'once off stay off' policy, cars are not permitted back onto the fields to stop them getting rutted. Unless exceptionally wet, cars will be able to come back onto the fields at the end of the week for you to pack up camp. Parking is available in the car park, using the parking permit. Don't park in front of the Church.
- If you are expecting an on-line food delivery please let the Site Manager know. Depending on the weather /state of the field the delivery may need to be carried from the car park.
- No smoking, including e-cigarettes, is allowed on the camping fields or in the toilets and showers.
- Rubbish and recycling bins are situated on the car park. Please recycle your card/paper, and also tins, cans, glass and plastics.
- Please abide by our Terms and Conditions these are displayed on the marquee noticeboard or can be found on FAQs on the camp website
